got sick. Most died.

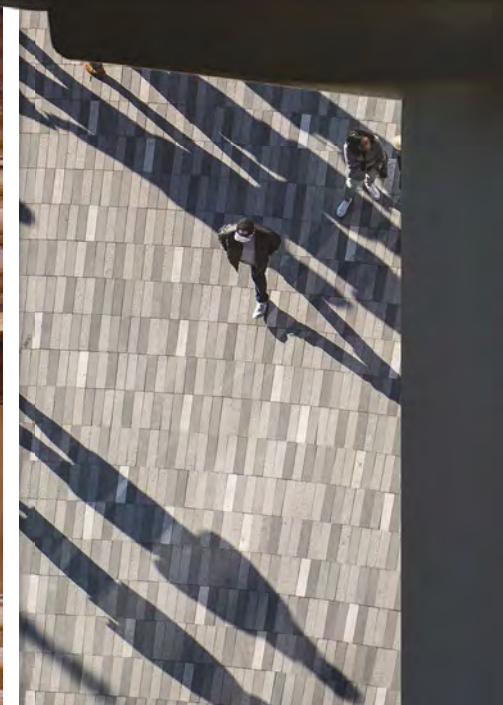







A few of **our** leaders came together. They made a plan. Small towns were formed. Each one had 50 cabins.










Huge clocks were made. One was set up in each town. Somehow the clocks were in sync.



You can see it in books. A park might have a statue. Murals add color to city streets.





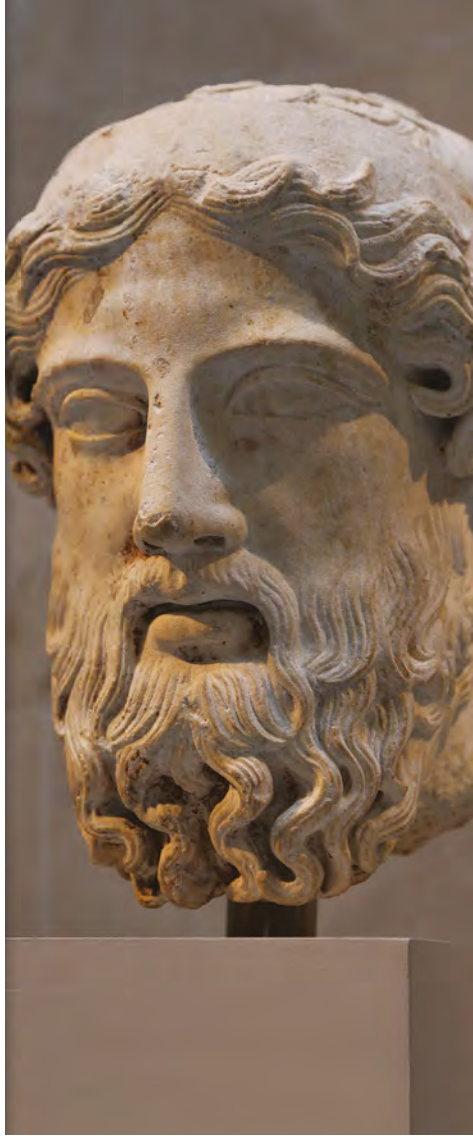


Many go to museums. All kinds of art can be seen there.
